Miguel Angel Ibarz Serraclara

Biografia

Miguel Angel Ibarz Serraclara born in Barcelona in 1958 is a Spaniard artist in love with the landscape and light of southern England where he has lived the last months.

After her last exhibition at the Brick Lane Gallery in London, takes a sample of his original watercolors and graphic works on paper at the Brunswick Town of Brighton based on his numerous sketches made during his trip.

Son of Maria Gloria Serraclara, cousin of Salvador Dalí, spends his summers in Cadaqués involved in the particular and fantastic world of bohemian 60s.

Professionally dedicated only to the watercolor, he combines his work with numerous collaborations for the publishing world to gradually move to paint only Galleries.

Miguel Angel is known for his landscapes and for his watercolors of flowers, topics that are especially comfortable.

As the art critic and friend Salarich says, "in the case of Miguel Angel, you will see it ! , the work, in secret, when look, will be leaving to become imagination "

Because, the son of Miguel Angel and Maria Gloria Serraclara passes childhood surrounded by artists of the Sala Gaspar from Barcelona, which represented, among others, Miró, Picasso, Clavé, his father Miguel Ibarz and naturally, the whole Barcelona elite art world of the time.
